Pass $\quad 8+\mathrm{hp}$, at least four diamonds (3). Forcing to $2 \star \lim 1 N T$ or PEN D.
1NT Nat, max ca 8hp. Doublers $2 \&$ is Stayman (later bids at three level except raises, are forcing). Other bids on 1NT are limited.

RESP expects 11-16 and bids systematically. $2 *$ is pass towards 11-16. After which jumping bids are strongly INV, while 2NT is FG (Conv).

## $12.5(1 *)-2 * / *$

Relay shows bad cards (2NT FG), 2 ca 4 -7hp and some kind of SUPP (new suits F1). Other FG, 2NT w/o five card suit and jump over $3 / \wedge$ splinter w/SUPP.
$12.6(1 *)-P-(1 \vee / \oplus)$
D is T/O and cuebid is NAT. After bid a new suit is F1, enemy suit is NAT or SUPP.

## $12.7(1 \diamond)-P-(P)$

Bidding as in second position, perhaps 2-3hp weaker. After D, $2 \star$ is NAT and 2\& INV.
