SYSTEM SUMMARY

GENERAL APPROACH AND STYLE
 Natural with 4-card M, 14-16 Nt. 2♣ is only forcing bid. 2/1 is GF and 1Nt 6-12 Semi forcing.

With 2 4-card suits we open in priority ♥, ♣, ♠ and ♦.

With 5-5 we always open highest.

Doubles are very often for TO, aggressive reopening bids and doubles.

SPECIAL BIDS THAT MAY REQUIRE DEFENCE
 After 1M - 1NT (or 1♠), 2♣ is conventional any 16+ with 5+M or natural 5+M and 3+♣ (3 with 5332 and a hand that you dont like to treat as a balanced hand)

2♦ Multi, weak M 3-10 hcp.

2♥ 54+ or 45+ in M, 7-11 hcp.

SPECIAL FORCING PASS SEQUENCES
 After 1X- (D)- RD, and similar situations when its clear that we have the majority of the HCP, pass is forcing when bidding is below 2NT.

OPENING LEADS STYLE

Subseq	2nd/4th through declearer.	

Might lead lowest from 4 card suit when 3rd can be important, K1082 etc.
 Russianow leads from honors against 3NT gambling and similar situations.

Against 5-level and higer suit contracts a lead of a K asks for count.

DOUBLES

TAKEOUT DOUBLES (Style; Response; Reopening)
 Aggressive 10(9)+ Hcp with ideal shape 4441.
 After (1♠) - D - (P) 1Nt is conventionell weak 0-7 hcp, 2 level bids 8-12, cue is F1
 After a cue by responder to TO hand new suits are F1.
 Reopening D might be very weak, no extras is needed.

SPECIAL, ARTIFICIAL AND COMPETITIVE (RE-)DOUBLES
 Support D and RD to 2 in responders M.

Invitational D when no other bids can be used. (1♥ - (P) - 2♥ - (3♦) - D inv.)

Doubles are generally for TO.

DEFENSIVE AND COMPETITIVE BIDDING

OVERCALLS (Style; Responses; 1/2 Level; Reopening)
 Aggressive on 1-level, an overcall non vul and with a passed partner can be made on a really weak hand but preferably with a good suit. In second seat bids are a bit more constructive but can be relatively weak.
 Sound on 2-level usually a good 5+ suit and a good opening hand.

1NT OVERCALL (2nd/4th Live; Responses; Reopening)
 2nd seat 15-18, system on.
 4th seat 11(10)-14, system on.

JUMP OVERCALLS (Style; Responses; Unusual NT)
 Preemptive
 Jump to 2NT, 2 lowest and a good hand, atleast opening hand in his own suits.
 Jump to 2NT after (1x)- P - (P) shows 19-21 balanced.

DIRECT AND JUMP CUE BIDS (Style; Responses; Reopen)
 Direct cue bid shows highest suit and one more, same as a jump to 2NT.
 Jump cue asks for a stopper.

VS. NT (vs. Strong/ Weak; Reopening; PH)
 2♣ atleast 4-4 usually 5-4 in majors (2d denies 4c M, 2M 4c or 3 with 3-1 in M)
 2♦ weak or really strong overcall with a M.
 2♥/♠ Intermediate, 5+ suit and about 11-16 Hcp.

VS. PREEMPTS (Doubles; Cue-bids; Jumps; NT bids)
 D is for TO, reopening doubles might be very weak.
 Over weak 2M: 2Nt 15-18 Cue bid shows 5-5 minors and 4♦♦ 5+ 5 OM NF.
 Over 2D multi D is 13-15 balanced or 17+ (Next double is for TO). 2Nt 16-18.
 Pass followed by D is for TO.

Lebensohl is used when we still might have a game.

VS. ARTIFICIAL STRONG OPENINGS
 1-level is natural but might be lead directing with a 4-card suit and weak hand.
 NT bids shows a 2 suiter with ♣ and ♥ or ♦ and ♠, bids are P or Correct
 Suit bids are nat or the 2 higher ranked suits.

OVER OPPONENTS' TAKEOUT DOUBLE
 RD are 10+ and sets forcing pass to 2Nt, new D is for penalty.
